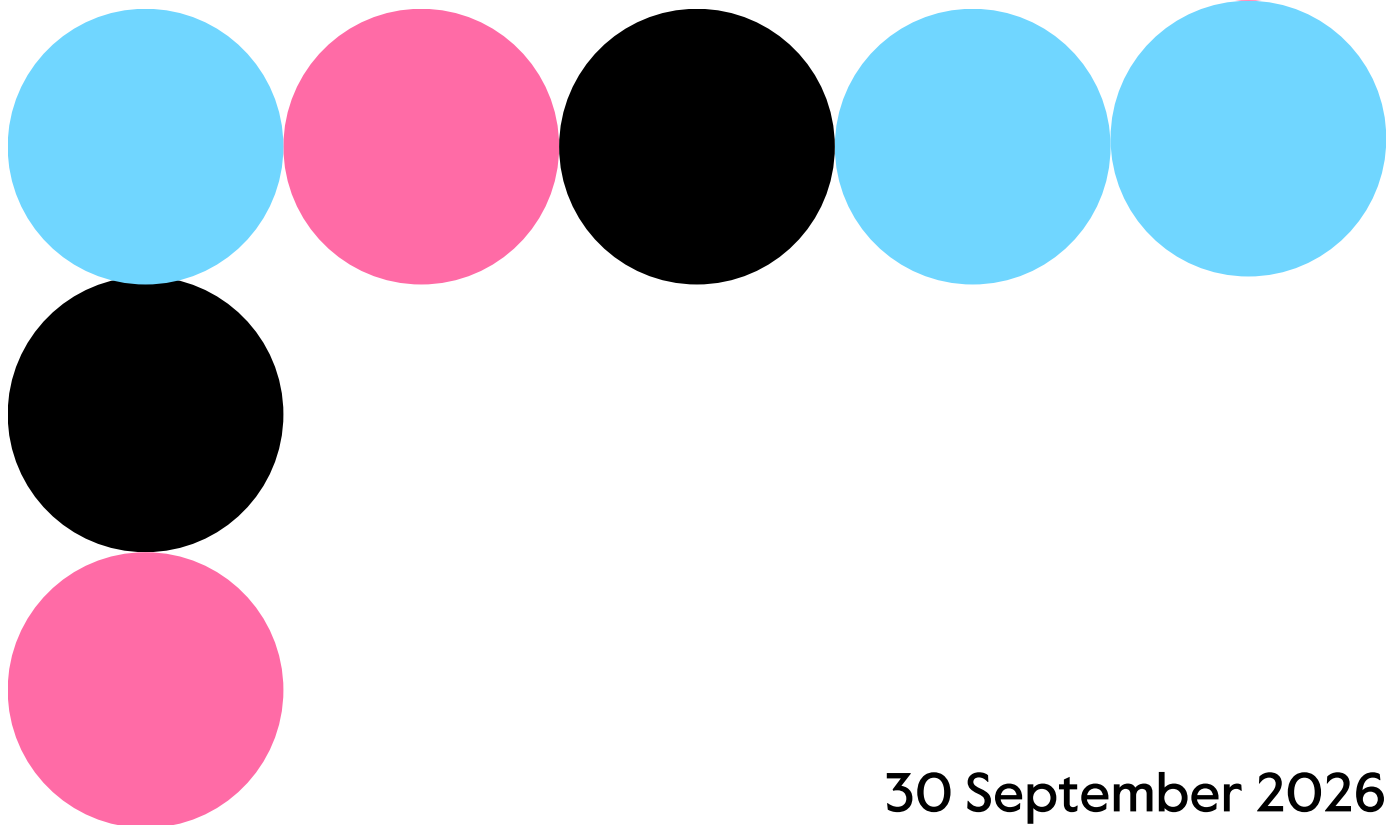

About the format

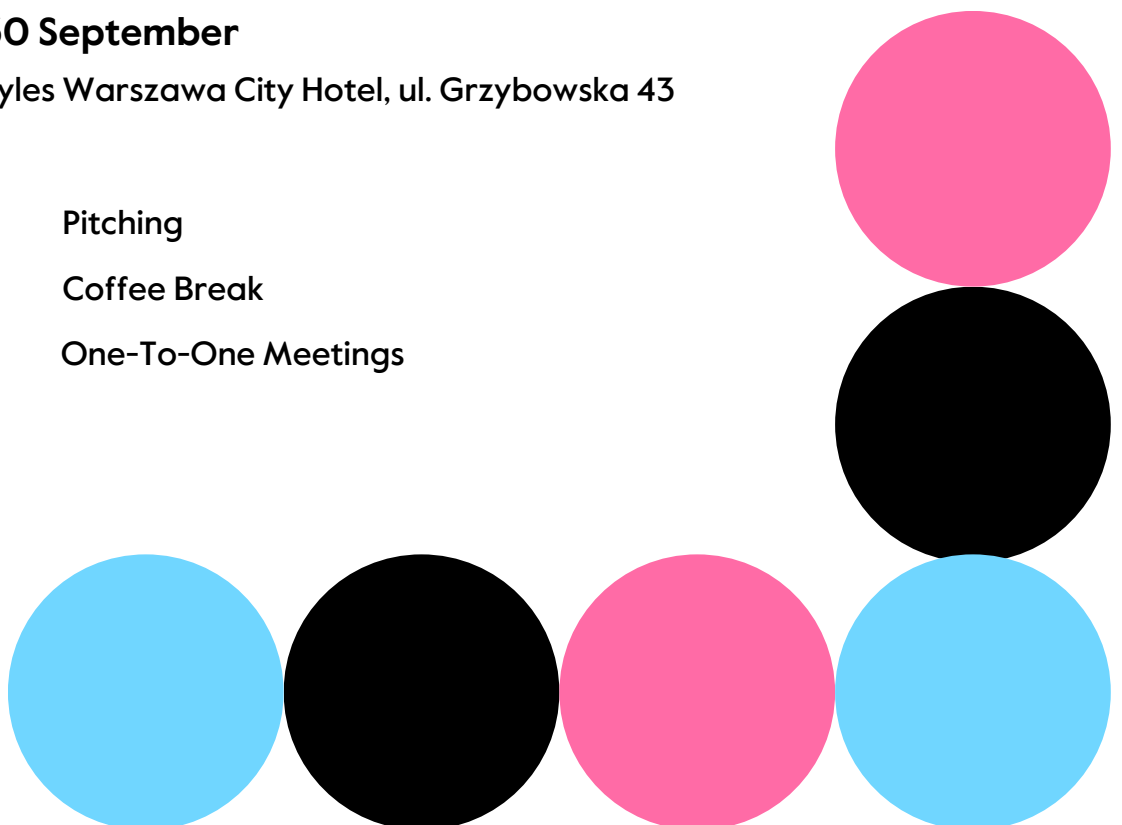
